"And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sin" ... "If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied." (1 Cor. 15:17; 19)

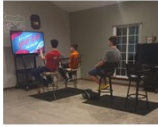

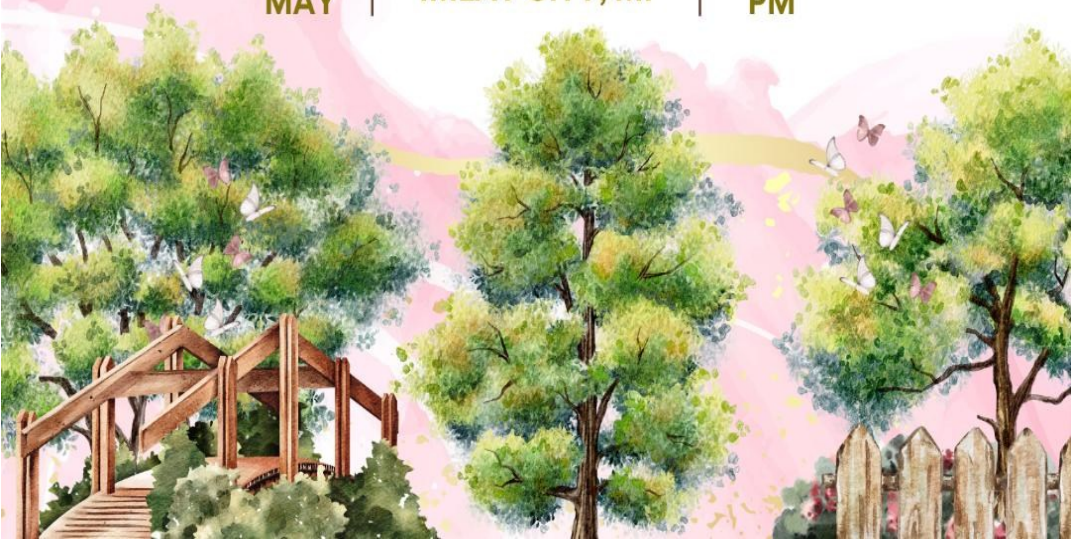
